



## College Uniform

Terms 1 and 4 — full summer uniform

Terms 2 and 3 — full winter uniform

### Girls

#### Summer

- College checked dress (below knee length)
- College bottle green V-necked jumper (R-9), navy jumper (10-12)
- St Francis de Sales College mid calf white socks
- Plain black leather lace up school shoes (R-2 velcro shoes allowed). Canvas shoes are not permitted.
- Brown Roman style sandals (R-2)
- College hat (to be worn in Term 1 and Term 4, Recess and Lunch)
- College blazer (6-12) all formal occasions and when the weather requires a warmer garment to and from the College, regardless of method of transport, in Term 1 and Term 4. The jumper may only be worn as the outer garment once inside the College grounds.

#### Winter

- College skirt (just below the knee, maximum 25cm from the ground) or Pinafore (optional, R-5)
- Lemon long sleeved shirt
- College tie (6-12)
- College bottle green V-necked jumper (R-9), navy jumper (10-12)
- College blue knee high socks or navy blue tights
- Plain black leather lace up school shoes (R-2 velcro shoes allowed). Canvas shoes are not permitted.
- College blue jacket (R-5)
- College blazer (6-12) for formal functions, including assemblies. The blazer is to be worn to and from the College, regardless of method of transport, in Term 2 and Term 3. The jumper may only be worn as the outer garment once inside the College grounds.

### Boys

#### Summer

- Charcoal shorts, either full or half elastic back
- Green/white short sleeved shirt
- College bottle green V-necked jumper (R-9), navy jumper (10-12)
- Plain charcoal socks
- Plain black leather lace up school shoes (R-2 velcro shoes allowed). Canvas shoes are not permitted.
- Brown Roman style sandals (R-2)
- College hat (to be worn in Term 1 and Term 4, Recess and Lunch)
- College blazer (6-12) all formal occasions and when the weather requires a warmer garment to and from the College, regardless of method of transport, in Term 1 and Term 4. The jumper may only be worn as the outer garment once inside the College grounds.

#### Winter

- Charcoal grey trousers
- Green/white long sleeved striped shirt
- College tie (6-12)
- College bottle green V-necked jumper (R-9), navy jumper (10-12)
- College blue winter jacket (R-5)

- Plain charcoal socks
- Plain black leather lace up school shoes (R-2 velcro shoes allowed). Canvas shoes are not permitted.
- College blazer (6-12) for formal functions, including assemblies. The blazer is to be worn to and from the College, regardless of method of transport, in Term 2 and Term 3. The jumper may only be worn as the outer garment once inside the College grounds.

## **Sports Uniform**

- College sports jumper (R-5), Jacket (6-12)
- College track pants
- College forest green polo shirt (including representing the College) or House polo shirt
- Navy blue College shorts
- White quarter crew socks
- Predominantly white sports shoes which provide support. This excludes flat canvas shoes (e.g. Dunlop Volleys) and high cut gym boots

## **General**

- College scarf
- St Francis de Sales College broad brim or bucket hat and bag
- Jewellery is not permitted with the College uniform. The only concessions are:
  - a pair of small, plain gold or silver stud or sleeper earrings or small pearl studs, one in the lower lobe of each ear
  - a thin chain necklace either plain or with a small cross or sacred medal
  - watch.

## **General Grooming**

- Hair needs to be kept away from the face at all times
- Hair ribbons and ties are to be in College colours only (navy blue, bottle green, gold). Hair ties of natural colour are permitted (brown, black, clear)
- No visible tattoos
- Make up is not to be worn with the College uniform
- Shirts are to be tucked in for winter (Terms 2 and 3)
- Long hair (shoulder length) needs to be tied back
- Hair style and colour needs to be appropriate for school and should not be designed to attract attention
- Boys should be clean shaven
